Dear Mr. Burke:

On September 23, 2010, Ohio EPA conducted an inspection of Main Street Lighting, Inc., located at 1080 Industrial Parkway, City of Medina, Medina County (site). During the inspection, I was accompanied by you. Ohio EPA records indicate that the site is covered by General National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System Permit for Storm Water Associated with Industrial Activity (General Storm Water Permit), permit No. 3GR01319\*DG.

A storm water pollution prevention plan (SWP3) is currently being developed for the site. After a discussion of the site's operation, it appears that the site may be eligible for an "industrial no exposure certification" if the lid serving the solid waste dumpster will remain closed. In order to qualify for the "industrial no exposure certification," please review U.S. EPA's "Guidance Manual for Conditional Exclusion from Storm water Permitting Based on No Exposure of Industrial Activities to Storm water" to verify that the site is eligible. If the site does qualify for the "industrial no exposure certification," Ohio EPA utilizes U.S. EPA's "NPDES Form 3510-11: No Exposure Certification for Exclusion from NPDES Storm water Permitting," which is also available at the above Web site. The "industrial no exposure certification" must be completed in accordance with the instructions and submitted to Ohio EPA at the following address:

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If the site does not qualify for the "industrial no exposure certification," the requirements of the General Storm Water Permit are still applicable to the site and an SWP3 would have to be developed and implemented.
