Dear Mr. Hatfield:

On August 16, 2010, this writer conducted an inspection of your facility located at 733 Weber Drive in Wadsworth, Ohio to determine compliance with your Industrial Storm Water NPDES General permit referenced above. The following observations were made:

General:

- Precision Aluminum Inc. produces aluminum cast products for the automobile industry.
- Drainage on the site is divided into three regions. The parking area, the storage area, and the grassy yard across the street each empty into a separate catch basin. These catch basins discharge into a creek running along the border of the property.

Inspection Observations:

- There were aluminum shavings on the ground near a storage drum. These should be swept up regularly.
- There were two hoppers on site. These should be kept covered to prevent storm water contamination.
