Dear Ms. Levitt:

On September 16, 2008, this writer conducted an inspection of your facility to determine compliance with state and federal stormwater regulations. At the time of the inspection, a recent storm had knocked out power to the area and the plant production was temporarily shut down. You accompanied me during the visit. The following is a summary of the inspection:

General

RTI Alloys Inc. formerly known as Galt Alloys Inc., is a manufacturer of Ferro Titanium and Ferro Aluminum alloys. The Ferro Titanium is processed into powders and the Ferro Aluminum is processed into ingots and nuggets. The Ball Mill is no longer present and Titanium turnings are no longer produced. There are no process waters generated at this facility. Potable water is supplied by the City of Canton. An on-site septic system serves the sanitary needs for the plant. There is one on-site groundwater well.

Stormwater

Since this office's last inspection, the titanium turnings are no longer produced and therefore no longer stored outside on a concrete pad. The un-weathered slag is stored inside and not exposed to precipitation.

The SWPPP plan was not available on site, which is a violation of the General Stormwater NPDES permit. Therefore this writer could not critique its completeness. We request that you submit the SWPPP within 10 days of receipt of this letter. We will review it and provide comment.
