Dear Mr. Shvorob:

On June 15, 2011 this writer conducted an inspection of your facility, located at 29980 Lakeland Blvd., Wickliffe, Ohio to determine compliance with your Industrial General Storm Water NPDES permit referenced above. Along with my observations from the inspection I have provided comments concerning your permit below:

General:

1. This site is the location of Universal Metal Products, a company that does metal stamping and finishing.
2. A filtration system is used to clean water generated from indoor activities.

Inspection Observations:

1. While walking around the outside of the building I noticed a few areas of concern. Behind the building towards the east, there were some used oil totes and drums of paint being stored outside. Although it is preferred that these full containers be stored indoors under roof, they could be stored on a containment tray or on a bermed concrete pad in order to contain any spills or leaks that may occur.
2. An uncovered general trash dumpster was docked in the receiving area partially covering a storm drain. This dumpster should be covered with a lid or tarp. It should also be monitored regularly to make sure no leaching is occurring into the storm drain or moved further from the drain.

Permit:

1. Your Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP) included a Pollution Prevention Team of only one member. It is recommended that the team consist of more than one person so that a member of the team is always on site if possible.

- Cover trash dumpster.
