Dear Ms. Godwin:

On August 5, 2009 this writer conducted an inspection of your facility to determine compliance with your Industrial General Stormwater NPDES permit referenced above. The following observations were made:

General

USF Holland Akron provides truck transportation (SIC code 4213) and warehousing located at 3140 Massillon Road, Summit County. No process or non-process wastewaters are produced. Sanitary wastewater is treated via an on-site dissipation system. No maintenance of trucks is done on the site.

Inspection observations

- 1) The site is unusual in that stormwater discharges via sheet flow, except for one obvious area near the southwest corner. Roof drains from the main building exit onto the surface of the parking lot.
- 2) A catch basin has been installed at a low point in the gravel area. The discharge is to the west. Your current SWPPP map dated 7/2/2008 does not show the catch basin or the discharge location. It must be amended.
- 3) The canopy for the fuel island has two downspout drains that discharge at an unknown location. We request that you determine to what they discharge and the point(s) they exit the property.

We have reviewed your SWPPP plan and have one comment. The SWPPP indicates that truck washing is done on the pavement by an outside vendor, contained and collected. We request that you verify if this still occurs and provide additional detail on how this is accomplished.
