Dear Mr. Alcox:

On June 21, 2010 this writer conducted an inspection of your facility, located at 10855 Market Street Ext. Rt. 7 in North Lima, Ohio to determine compliance with your Industrial General Storm Water NPDES permit referenced above. Along with my observations from the inspection I have provided comments concerning your SWPPP below:

General:

1. This site is the location of USF Holland Inc, a trucking company that provides a wide variety of transportation services.
2. Drainage on the site is directed to two outfalls on the eastern side of the property. These outfalls empty into a retention pond on the site.

Inspection Observations:

1. While walking around the outside of the building we noticed a few areas of concern. The main concern was general trash cleanup. Trash was accumulating in the loading/unloading docks, along the property's fence and around the trash hopper.
2. The trash hopper did not have a lid which was causing trash to blow out. The addition of a permanent or temporary cover would prevent this.
3. Throughout the site, there were several small puddles of oil. This should be cleaned up immediately to prevent contact with precipitation.

Permit:

1. The SWPPP should include the appropriate signatures as stated in paragraph G of Part VII of the permit.
2. Revise the SWPPP yearly and update it as necessary.


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Action Items

- Clean up trash throughout the site.
- Add a permanent or temporary cover to the trash hopper.
- Include certification signatures in the SWPPP.
