Subject: Failure to Monitor Drinking Water

Western Reserve Village is in violation of Ohio Administrative Code Rule (OAC) 3745-81-24 for failing to monitor your drinking water during the monitoring period and/or report results for the following contaminants: VOLATILE ORGANIC CONTAMINANTS.

In order to return to compliance, Western Reserve Village must take the following actions:

1. Immediately collect a sample of your drinking water from the entry point (first tap after treatment).
2. Submit the sample for analysis to a certified laboratory on the enclosed list.
3. Notify your customers using the enclosed instructions and public notice.
4. Complete and return the enclosed verification form to this office.
