Dear Mr. Sbardella:

On March 9, 2009 this writer conducted a compliance evaluation inspection of your facility for the purpose of determining compliance with the above referenced NPDES permit. Production is down drastically due to the recent economic downturn. Your facility is operating 3 to 4 days per week, still generating the same type of wastewaters.

During my last inspection on October 11, 2007 this writer informed you that this Agency had not been receiving your monthly operating reports for quite some time. You were instructed to contact Jamie Roberts, Ohio EPA, Central Office to work out your problems with SWIMWARE. You then verified that you were generating the reports by submitting hard copies to this office for the time period of 2003, 2005, 2006, 2007, and January of 2008. You were requested to amend the record by submitting these same reports to our central office by c.d. or by hard copy. The record shows that this has not been accomplished even though 17 months have passed.

This writer has also been requesting that your company submit a written action plan to eliminate the discharge of orange colored water at outfall 3IQ00049001 since July 2006. A copy of the July 16, 2006 letter is attached for your reference. This request was repeated in a letter dated October 17, 2007 (copy attached) and during our meeting on March 9, 2009.

In this writer's letter of October 17, 2007 you were also requested to install a sampling station to capture all of your process wastewater discharges prior to entering the pond. To date this also has not been accomplished.

In summary the following outstanding issues remain at your facility and must be addressed:

- 1) The historical data dating back to 2003 must be submitted to our Central Office to update your compliance record. For data before April 1, 2006 you need to work with Ed Swindall, DSW, Central Office. After April 1, 2006 Jamie Roberts, Central Office can help you with this update.

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- 2) Submit the above referenced action plan.
- 3) Install a proper monitoring station to monitor all process wastewaters.

These issues must be resolved by April 17, 2009. Failure to do so will necessitate that we initiate an enforcement action as allowed by Ohio Revised Code 61111. We will seek civil and monetary penalties.
