Dear Mr. Vargo:

On June 30, 2011 this writer conducted a compliance evaluation inspection of your facility to determine compliance with the above referenced NPDES permit. You were present during the inspection.

A small volume of cars are still processed by removing and capturing fluids. The cars that are processed only have the tops crushed for stacking prior to transit.

Inspection Observations

- 1) No oil stains were observed in the watershed area tributary to the oil/water separator and outfall 001.
- 2) The polishing vault had a very slight sheen in between the vertical absorbent plates.
- 3) It was suggested that the outlet to the polishing vault be fitted with a tee or down turned pipe to draw below the static surface water level. Also add the absorbent pads to remove any floatable oil.
- 4) The SWPPP was reviewed and found to substantially meet the requirements of the permit. A plot plan should be added that details all areas of potential stormwater exposure (e.g. dumpsters, crushed car storage area, diesel fuel tank, etc...). All storm sewers and catch basins must be located on the drawing. General drainage patterns should be noted.

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
