**NOTICE OF VIOLATION: NOTIFICATION VIOLATION**

CL 07 123  
Dear Mr. Dedonno:

On 12/21/06, the Cleveland Division of Air Quality (CDAQ) received a notification for asbestos removal for The Cleveland Clinic Foundation. This letter serves as notification that you are operating or have operated an asbestos renovation project (ARP) in violation of the following applicable air statutes or air regulations.

Renovation projects are subject to compliance with the Asbestos National Emission Standard for Hazardous Air Pollutants (NESHAP), Title 40 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) Part 61 Subpart M, and the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) Rule 3745-20.

The ARP violates 40 CFR 61.145(b)(3)(ii) in that CDAQ did not receive written notification 10 working days before the end of the calendar year preceding the year for which notice is being given.

Unless you undertake some type of corrective action with respect to the above noted violation, you will remain in non-compliance. CDAQ requests that Pioneer Environmental Systems Inc. Center provide assurance that no RACM will be disturbed prior to January 9, 2007 and a commitment that future notifications will be submitted in a timely manner. Your written response to this letter must be received by CDAQ within fourteen (14) days of your receipt of this letter. If there is insufficient time to correct the alleged violations within this timeframe, your response must include a timeline for correcting the alleged violations.

Violations of Ohio air pollution laws and /or permit terms and conditions are subject to the penalties stipulated in Ohio Revised Code Section 3704.99(A), which allows fines of not more



than twenty-five thousand dollars or imprisonment for not more than one year, or both, for each violation.

CDAQ issues this letter with Ohio EPA's concurrence. The failure to mention any specific violation does not excuse any violations of local, state and federal laws or regulations regarding air pollution control. Violations of air pollution control laws may be pursued in local court or referred to Ohio EPA or U.S. EPA for further enforcement action. 
Thank you for taking my telephone call and discussing the Mr. George Baker letter dated January 8, 2007, a copy of which is attached to this letter.

Please contact me if there is anything else you need from me.



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

**NOTICE OF VIOLATION FOLLOW-UP LETTER**

Dear Mr. Dedonno:

On January 8, 2007, the Cleveland Division of Air Quality (CDAQ) issued a Notice of Violation requiring Pioneer Environmental Systems Inc. to turn in a blanket notification 10 working days before the end of the calendar year. CDAQ is in receipt of a corrective action plan dated January 18, 2007 and notes that no ACM removal took place before January 9, 2007.

The corrective action plan was received in a timely manner and appropriate steps were taken to bring the source into compliance. CDAQ has determined that no further enforcement action is warranted at this time, but reserves its right to take such action in the future if necessary.

CDAQ issues this letter with Ohio EPA's concurrence and does not excuse any violations of local, state and federal laws or regulations regarding air pollution control.
