This letter confirms a visit by the Tri-County Joint Fire District to your property at 10414 State Route 62, NE, Mount Sterling, wherein they observed that you were open burning in violation of Ohio Administrative Code(OAC) 3745-19-04(A). These actions are subject to fines and penalties.

Specifically, on July 18, 2012, and at 10414 State Route 62, NE, Mount Sterling, you were open burning construction debris.

This letter is not a final action of the Director of the Ohio EPA and is intended only as a notification of a violation of the Ohio environmental laws and regulations. It does not preclude Ohio EPA or any other governmental entity from further enforcement action.
