**Subject: Failure to Notify Ohio EPA of positive total coliform (TC) samples within required time frame**

Belmont Laboratories is in violation of Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) Rule 3745-89-08(B) for failing to report a positive sample no later than the end of the next business day.

OAC Rule 3745-89-08(B)

*"All positive and all repeat sample results required by rules 3745-81-14 and 3745-81-21 of the Administrative Code, and all microbial monitoring results required by rule 3745-81-42 of the Administrative Code shall be reported to the director electronically via a method acceptable to the director and to the public water systems either by fax, electronically via a method acceptable to the director, or by overnight mail delivery by no later than the end of the next business day after the result was obtained."*


