The Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA), Southwest District Office (SWDO), received the 2011 Village of Cedarville Closed Landfill Annual Report on May 7, 2012. Additional information was submitted June 8, 2012, following Ohio EPA correspondence to the village of Cedarville dated May 23, 2012, requesting the appropriate form be used and that a cost estimate be provided.
