Dear Mr. Maxwell:

Thank you for your August 7, 2012 response to Ohio EPA's July 25, 2012 Notice of Violation letter. Your response included an explanation of the "generator knowledge" you used to evaluate the material in the drums as required by *OAC Rule 3745-52-11, Hazardous Waste Determination*, and photographic documentation that drums and tanks on-site containing used oil have been correctly labeled with the words "Used Oil" as required by *OAC Rule 3745-279-22(C), Used Oil Storage Requirements for Generators*. You also addressed Ohio EPA's concern regarding storage of scrap tires on-site by demonstrating that they have been covered with tarps to prevent rain water from collecting in them.

My review of the documentation you submitted shows that One Stop Auto & Tire has abated all violations discovered during the July 19, 2012 hazardous waste inspection.
