Dear Mr. Paxton:

On March 8, 2011, I inspected the wastewater discharge at your facility located at 3640 Hoffman Road, Toledo, Lucas County. The facility's discharge is regulated by an NPDES permit.


The facility is a demolition materials landfill. The wastewater source is the runoff from several areas of the facility including gravel and dirt roadways, covered landfill cells, and active cells. A wastewater sedimentation pond is used for treatment of the collected runoff prior to an overflow discharge. There was no discharge occurring at the time of inspection and the pond surface appeared frozen.

Our records indicate that your facility has not submitted a monthly operating report (MOR) since the issuance of the latest NPDES permit on July 20, 2005. This is a violation of the permit. The permit expired on August 31, 2010. As of the date of this letter, we haven't received a renewal application for the expired permit. Please note that you must have a valid and current NPDES permit to continue discharges of wastewater from your facility in accordance with Ohio Administrative Code (OAC). Please submit a renewal application (Blank copy attached) to our office as soon as possible but not later than April 30, 2011, to avoid escalated enforcement action for non-compliance.

I will be conducting follow up inspections in the near future to observe the operation of the treatment system and quality of the discharged water.
