
On March 24, 2011, I inspected the wastewater discharge at your facility on Hoffman Road, Toledo, Lucas County.

The wastewater was discharging from the sedimentation pond into the receiving stream. The discharged water appeared murky.

Please note all efforts should be made to collect at least one sample of the discharge per month so that compliance with the permit can be verified. This is a requirement of the NPDES permit. Failure to comply with NPDES permit can be cause for escalated enforcement action which can include penalties.
