Dear Mr. Nichols:

This office received a complaint on April 22, 2010, concerning open burning being conducted on your property. I investigated the complaint on April 26, 2010. My investigation shows household trash including plastics, brush, leaves, construction and demolition debris, a mattress and upholstered furniture was burned for disposal purposes. A fire origination from your property is also believed to have started a fire that burned approximately 40 acres of an adjacent corn stubble field on or about April 12, 2010. The above violations occurred within 1000' of adjacent residences in an unrestricted area.

Based on my findings, there is sufficient evidence to determine that illegal open burning did occur and the complaint is justified. This is a violation of OAC rule 3745-19-04(A). A copy of the OAC rules pertaining to open burning has been enclosed for your review.

Please submit a written response to Ohio EPA, Northwest District Office indicating your understanding of the regulations and your commitment that no future illegal open burning will occur. Your response should be received by this agency no later than May 17, 2010.

Please be advised that the submission of information to respond to this letter does not constitute waiver of the Ohio EPA's authority to seek civil penalties pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 3704.06. The Ohio EPA will make a decision whether to pursue such penalties regarding this matter at a later date.

Fresh evergreen tree trimmings appear to have been added since the last burn. Per reporting FD, this is the cause of a 40 acre stubble field fire. There was also a burn barrel which contained signs of burning household trash with plastics & C&DD.
