Both you and your mother admitted that you conducted the burning in effort to maintain the property for your parents.

Based on my findings, there is sufficient evidence to determine that illegal open burning did occur and the complaint is justified. This is a violation of OAC rule 3745-19-04(A) and this is found to be the second time a violation of this rule occurred at this property. A copy of the OAC rules pertaining to open burning has been enclosed for your review. This situation will also be brought to the attention of the property owner and they will also receive a copy of the rules.

Please submit a written response to Ohio EPA, Northwest District Office indicating your understanding of the regulations and your commitment that no future illegal open burning will occur. Your response should be received by this agency no later than **August 17, 2009**.

Please be advised that the submission of information to respond to this letter does not constitute waiver of the Ohio EPA's authority to seek civil penalties pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 3704.06. I was given permission by the complainant to observe and photograph the suspect's burn sites from his property. I observed aluminum cans, steel cans, glass bottles, glass jars, a metal spade shovel, a plastic snow shovel and what appeared to be bits of plastic in the southernmost burn site. Aside from one piece of something blue (assuming plastic), the northern burn site appeared to contain all wood remnants.			
When leaving the area, Rebecca Rice waved me onto the property. She explained that she and her husband had not been home at the time when the most recent burning occurred.
