Dear Mr. Rush:

On April 12, 2010, I met with you to conduct an inspection of the sewage treatment facilities serving your restaurant.

My inspection revealed that your facility is served by only a two compartment septic tank with discharge to an unnamed tributary to the Maumee River. The discharge appeared septic and the receiving stream appeared septic at the location of discharge and just downstream.

Our records indicate that your facility's monthly operating reports indicate exceedances of the permit limitation for total suspended solids, ammonia, CBOD 5, and fecal coliform bacteria consistently. Your NPDES permit Part I, C – Schedule of Compliance, required that engineering plans be submitted and approved and construction be completed within 32 months of the effective date of the current permit. This office has not received any correspondence or documentation regarding this term of your permit.

Please note that you are in violation of the terms and conditions of your NPDES permit. Continued violations will subject your facility to escalated enforcement actions that include civil or criminal penalties.


Your NPDES permit expired on February 28, 2010. This office has not received a renewal application for the permit. Forms 1 and 2E are enclosed for your use to complete and submit to this office as soon as possible.

Please provide this office in writing, reasons for the above mentioned violations and actions to be taken to correct these violations no later than June 1, 2010. Failure to respond by this date will result in an enforcement referral to the Director of Ohio EPA.



The County Commissioners have authorized a total of \$48,000. in grants from the Paulding County Revolving Loan Fund, managed by the Paulding County Economic Development office, to do feasibility studies and tests for water and sewer improvements to the area. These studies and tests are for proper planning and also to meet the requirements to apply for grants and low interest loans to do the project. Also, the Village of Cecil has installed an infrastructure sleeve under the new US 24 to allow for service to both sides of the highway. We are now at the point of legally setting up an organization to build and operate the project.
