Dear Mr. Brummer and Mr. Gue:

On June 16, 2011, I performed an inspection at the above-referenced site to determine compliance with the Ohio EPA General Storm Water National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Permit for Construction Activities #3GC04925*AG. Our records indicate that ODNR DMRM was granted coverage under the NPDES permit on May 21, 2010.

During my inspection, I did not document any deficiencies. Please continue to maintain all sediment control practices until the site reaches final stabilization. Final stabilization means that all soil disturbing activities at the site are complete and a uniform perennial vegetative cover (i.e., evenly distributed, without large bare areas) has reached a growth density of 70% or greater on all unpaved areas and areas not covered by permanent structures. Equivalent stabilization measures, such as the use of landscape mulches, rip-rap, or gabions, may be employed, where appropriate, in lieu of vegetation. When you determine that the site has reached final stabilization, please remove all control devices and submit a Notice of Termination (NOT) within a 45 day period.
