
On August 2, 2011, Ohio EPA conducted an inspection of the Joe's Deli project located at 19215 Hilliard Blvd., City of Rocky River, Cuyahoga County, Ohio. EPA records indicate that the site is covered by the General National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Permit for Storm Water Associated with Construction Activity (General Storm Water Permit), permit No. 3GC05396*AG. I spoke with Jeff Toghill, Project Superintendent of Fortney & Weygandt Inc. while on site. The inspection was conducted as a follow-up to an inspection conducted on June 21, 2011, and documented the following:

- **The issues documented during the previous inspection have been corrected.**
 - Please be sure to maintain all of the Best Management Practices (BMP's) for the remainder of the construction process.

- **The concrete wash pit was full, and had the potential of overflowing.**
 - Please be sure to empty the wash pit and dispose of wash water appropriately (See Figure 1).
