
Dear Mr. Philips:

On August 3, 2011, Ohio EPA conducted an inspection of the Auburn Township Fire Station project located at 10950 E. Washington Street, City of Chagrin Falls, Geauga County. Ohio EPA records indicate that the site is covered by the General National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Permit for Storm Water Associated with Construction Activity (General Storm Water Permit), permit No. 3GC05254\*AG. I spoke with Joe Olson of Hummel Construction while on site. The inspection documented the following:

- **A copy of the Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan (SWP3) was available on site.**
  - Please be sure the SWP3 is always available on site. After reviewing the SWP3, it appeared to be adequate. Please be sure all Best Management Practices and Erosion and Sediment Controls are installed according to the SWP3 within seven (7) days of all initial earth-disturbing activities.
