Dear Mr. Routzahn:

On June 22, 2010, Ohio EPA conducted an inspection of the Painesville Harvey High School project, located at 167 Washington Street, City of Painesville, Lake County (site). Ohio EPA records indicate that the site is covered by the General National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Permit for Storm Water Associated with Construction Activity (General Storm Water Permit), permit No. 3GC04847\*AG. The inspection revealed the following:

- The demolition has been completed. Final grading is currently taking place.

Michael Bentley of D. B. Bentley Excavating Inc. stated that he expects the site to be completed within the next couple of weeks. You are eligible to terminate the NPDES Permit once all of the following criteria are met:

1. All temporary erosion and sediment controls are removed and disposed.
2. All trapped sediments have been permanently stabilized to prevent further erosion.
3. All soil disturbing activities on this site have been completed.
4. A uniform, perennial vegetative cover (or other permanent stabilization technique) has been established to a 70% growth density on all disturbed soils.

This permit may be terminated by filing a Notice of Termination (NOT) which can be obtained from:
