On July 21, 2011, I performed an inspection at the above-referenced site to determine compliance with the Ohio EPA General Storm Water National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Permit for Construction Activities #3GC05062\*AG. Our records indicate that the City of Aurora was granted coverage under the NPDES permit on August 23, 2010.

During my inspection, I did not document any deficiencies. The entire site has been seeded, and vegetation has taken root in most areas. Please continue to monitor the site to ensure that the vegetation fill in appropriately. Then, when the site achieves a vegetative growth of 70% or greater on all unpaved surfaces, you may submit a Notice of Termination (NOT) to Ohio EPA to terminate NPDES permit coverage.
