Dear Mr. Manering:

On July 5, 2012, Ohio EPA conducted a complaint investigation of your automotive repair business in Jackson, Ohio, in response to a complaint received by this office alleging improper management of automotive fluids. Based on the investigation, Ohio EPA sent you a Notice of Violation letter on July 12, 2012.

Ohio EPA re-inspected Angles Garage on July 27, 2012 to ascertain that violations had been abated. During this site visit, I observed that oil-contaminated soils had been excavated and that used oil containers were properly labeled. Based on my re-inspection and on additional documentation that you emailed to me on August 16, 2012, which included a landfill receipt for disposal of oil-contaminated soils as well as a receipt from Safety Kleen for management of parts washer fluid, Angles Garage has now abated all violations discovered during the July 5, 2012 investigation.
