Dear Mr. Horner:

On September 4, 2008, the Wapakoneta City School District received coverage under the Ohio EPA General Permit for Storm Water Associated with Construction Activity (CGP) for the Cridersville Elementary School. This CGP is still active and you are named as a contact for this site.

On May 25, 2011, I performed an inspection of this site, located at 501 Reichelderfer Road, in the Village of Cridersville, Auglaize County, OH. The purpose of this visit was to evaluate compliance of the site with the CGP. The inspection was conducted under the provisions of Ohio's water pollution control statutes, Ohio Revised Code (ORC) Chapter 6111. As a result of this inspection, it appears that coverage for this site is eligible to be terminated.

Construction activities appear to have been completed with final stabilization achieved on all portions of this site. The CGP requires that a Notice of Termination (NOT) must be filed to relieve the applicant of the obligation to comply with the terms and conditions of this general permit including regular inspections of the site. I am enclosing an NOT form and instructions to be submitted to terminate this permit.
