
Dear Mr. Meadows:

On July 14, 2011, Ohio EPA conducted an inspection of the Burnett Street Farm project located at 5684 Burnett Street, Warren Township, Trumbull County. Ohio EPA records indicate that the site is covered by the General National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Permit for Storm Water Associated with Construction Activity (General Storm Water Permit), permit No. 3GC04955\*AG. The inspection was conducted as a follow-up to my last inspection on May 26, 2011, and documented the following:

- The site appears to have remained idle since the last visit, and the same issues are still visible. I spoke with Jake Gore of Trumbull SWCD, and he informed me that he is still waiting to see a revised Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan (SWP3) from you. Please submit a revised SWP3 to Jake, as well as to OEPA before continuing any further construction activities.
- Please stabilize any disturbed areas of the site which will remain idle for twenty one (21) days or greater to prevent any further erosion (See Figures 1 & 2).

Please provide me with a letter of response indicating the actions you will take to address the deficiencies noted above. Your response must be received and corrective action completed by August 1, 2011. If corrective action cannot be completed by this date, your response should include the date by when corrections will be completed.
