On July 15, 2010, Ohio EPA conducted an inspection of the Jefferson K-8 School project, located at 903 Fifth St. SW, City of Warren, Trumbull County (site). Ohio EPA records indicate that the site is covered by the General National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Permit for Storm Water Associated with Construction Activity (General Storm Water Permit), permit No. 3GC04132*AG. The inspection documented the following:

- Sediment deposition was observed offsite, at the southeast corner of the proposed football field (Figure 1). Install silt fence as noted in the site's storm water pollution prevention plan (SWP3).
- Temporarily seed any areas of the site that will remain idle for 21 days or longer or permanently seed areas that are at final grade.
- Construction of the K-8 building is complete. The remainder of the site consists of a school demolition and athletic fields. Topsoil was being spread in the areas around the K-8 School at the time of inspection.

A written report detailing how the above deficiencies will be addressed must be submitted to Ohio EPA within seven days of receiving this letter. The above deficiencies must be addressed within 14 days of receiving this letter.
