Dear Mr. Bogan:

This letter confirms my visit to 1800 E. Broad Street, Pataskala, Ohio wherein I observed that you have been open burning in violation of Ohio Administrative Code rule 3745-19-03(A). These actions are subject to fines and penalties.

Specifically, at 1800 E. Broad Street, Pataskala, you have been open burning asphalt shingles and copper wire. Additionally, this open burning (and the open burning of other waste) was occurring in a Restricted Area and also within 1,000 feet from the nearest inhabited building off said premises.

This letter is not a final action of the Director of the Ohio EPA and is intended only as a notification of a violation of the Ohio environmental laws and regulations. It does not preclude Ohio EPA or any other governmental entity from further enforcement action.
