Dear Mr. Kieffer and Mr. Haynes:

On December 2, 2010, I inspected the Huron River Boat Access located at 41 East Cleveland Street, Huron. The purpose of the visit was to evaluate compliance of the site with the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit for storm water discharges associated with construction activity, Facility ID No 2GC02362. The inspection was conducted under the provisions of Ohio's water pollution control statutes, Ohio Revised Code (ORC) Chapter 6111.

It appears that the boat ramp and paved parking lot are complete. Extended detention basins appeared to have been installed as the post construction storm water management facilities. A Notice of Termination must be filed to relieve you of the obligation to comply with this general permit. An NOT may be filed if one or more of the following conditions have been met:

- Final stabilization has been established on all areas of the site for which the permittee is responsible. Final stabilization means that all soil disturbing activities at the site are complete and a uniform perennial vegetative cover of at least 70% density has been established over the entire site. All temporary erosion and sediment control measures have been removed, properly disposed of, and all trapped sediment has been permanently stabilized
- Another operator(s) has assumed control over all areas of the site that have not been fully stabilized.


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Your site does not yet appear to meet all of the conditions mentioned above. While the site had been seeded and straw mulch applied, there remained a few areas where the grass cover had not yet reached a 70% density. Once you meet this criteria, please file the NOT form. The NOT form and instructions can be found on our website:
