Dear Mr. Rupp:

On May 26, 2005, Fulton County Health Center received coverage under the Ohio EPA General Permit for Storm Water Associated with Construction Activity (CGP) for the Fulton County Health Center. This CGP is still active and you are named as a contact for this site.

On June 6, 2011, I performed an inspection of this site, located at 725 South Shoop Avenue in the City of Wauseon, Fulton County, Ohio. The purpose of this visit was to evaluate compliance of the site with the CGP. The inspection was conducted under the provisions of Ohio's water pollution control statutes, Ohio Revised Code (ORC) Chapter 6111. As a result of this inspection, it appears that coverage for this site is eligible to be terminated.

Construction activities have been completed with final stabilization achieved on all portions of this site. The CGP requires that a Notice of Termination (NOT) must be filed to relieve the applicant of the obligation to comply with the terms and conditions of this general permit including regular inspections of the site. While you did send a letter to us requesting termination of the permit, an NOT form must be submitted in order to terminate the CGP. I am enclosing an NOT form and instructions to terminate this permit.
