Dear Mr. Doyle:

On September 29, 2010, Ben Smith and I inspected Apple Blossom Farms Plats 8 and 9, located south of Pilliod Road and west of Gunn Road, Springfield Township. The purpose of the visit was to evaluate compliance of the sites with the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit for storm water discharges associated with construction activity, Facility ID Nos. 2GC00356 and 2GC00594. The inspection was conducted under the provisions of Ohio's water pollution control statutes, Ohio Revised Code (ORC) Chapter 6111.

At the time of the inspection, construction activities were not occurring in either plat. Roads and utilities had been installed. In Plat 8, five homes had been built and two lots remain unoccupied. In Plat 9, two multi-unit condominiums had been completed. It appeared that the unbuilt portions of both developments had been stabilized. An extended detention basin was located along the southeast side of Plat 9.

It appears that both sites are in compliance with the permit at this time. If there are any questions, please contact me at (419) 373-3009.
