Dear Mr. Frendt:

On November 4, 2010, I inspected Blue Creek Recreation Area located on the northeast corner of Providence Street and Stile Road, Whitehouse. The purpose of the visit was to evaluate compliance of the site with the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit for storm water discharges associated with construction activity, Facility ID No.2GC02150. The inspection was conducted under the provisions of Ohio's water pollution control statues, Ohio Revised Code (ORC) Chapter 6111. Ohio EPA has no record of other permittees for this project.

At the time of my visit, there was no earthwork occurring. The northern ball diamonds were complete and the waterlines installed. The remainder of the site appeared to be stabilized. According to our December 29, 2010, phone conversation, the construction of another four baseball diamonds and paving of parking lots still remains to be done. It appears that the site is in compliance with the permit.

Due to the absence of personnel, the Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plans (SWP3) and inspection logs were not available for review. Within 10 days of the date on this letter, please submit a copy of the site's Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan to this office for our records. Your SWP3 must fulfill all of the requirements of Part III.G. of the permit, including the requirements for post construction storm water management.
