Dear Mr. Danford:

On September 20, 2010, Ohio EPA received a complaint from the Gilcrest Wellness Center about a possible illicit discharge to the municipal separate storm sewer system (MS4). The complainant states swimming pool filter backwash is being discharged to the MS4. The discharge originates from a swimming pool located at 61 Homan Drive, but enters the MS4 via the storm sewer system that serves the Gilcrest property located at 593 Gates Street. In addition to this possible illicit discharge of wastewater, the hillside onto which this discharge is released is eroding. This is causing sediment to enter the MS4.

This letter will serve to notify the Village of Doylestown about the presence of these potential illicit discharges. Per the obligations of the Ohio EPA General Storm Water National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Permit for Small MS4s #3GQ00032*BG, please conduct an illicit discharge investigation to determine if an illicit discharge exists and if so, take all steps necessary to remove the source(s) of illicit discharge to the MS4. Please submit documentation of the investigation, its findings, outcomes and plan for corrective action to me **no later than October 30, 2010**. Please include a description of any enforcement actions taken under Chapter 929 of the City's codified ordinances: Illicit Discharge and Illegal Connection Control.
