Dear Mayor and Council:

On November 19, 2008 and December 3, 2008, Ohio EPA met with representatives of the City of Hubbard and Trumbull County Soil and Water Conservation District to determine compliance with the Ohio EPA General Storm Water National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Permit for Small Municipal Separate Storm Sewers Systems (MS4s) #3GQ00002*AG, Ohio Administrative Code 3745-39, and the Storm Water Management Plan (SWMP) submitted by Trumbull County in March 2003.

Ohio EPA notified the City of Hubbard of deficiencies with its implementation of the SWMP by an audit report dated February 2, 2009. Ohio EPA requested the City of Hubbard to submit a letter of response detailing the specific actions that will be implemented to address the audit deficiencies. The letter of response was to be received by April 17, 2009. As of the date of this Notice of Violation (NOV), Ohio EPA has not received a letter of response that details how the audit deficiencies will be addressed by the City of Hubbard.

Failure to provide the requested letter of response by April 17, 2009 constitutes violations of Ohio Revised Code Chapter 6111 and Part V.E. of the MS4 NPDES permit, which states that “you shall furnish to the director, within seven days or as indicated in the written request, any information which the director may request to determine compliance with this permit.” The letter of response must be immediately submitted to Ohio EPA detailing how the audit deficiencies will be addressed.
