Dear Ms. Knapke:

On August 5, 2010, a storm water compliance inspection was made of the Celina Aluminum Precision Tech Inc (CAPT) facility, Celina, Mercer County, to determine compliance with the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System General Permit for Storm Water Associated with Industrial Activity (IGP) issued to this facility. The inspection consisted of a tour of the grounds outside of this facility and a review of the Stormwater Pollution Prevention Plan (SWP3). CAPT melts and casts aluminum products for Honda of America Mfg. Barb Rife, Environmental Coop was also present at the inspection.

The outside inspection found bits of metal on the ground near the recycling area which should be cleaned up. While there are no outside drains on the north side of the building, there is sheet flow through the grass to the ditch. The Omni Source hopper with miscellaneous scrap on the west side was not covered. The drains in the truck unloading area need to have the dirt removed. A spill kit should be kept in the vicinity of the truck unloading area.

A review of the SWP3 shows that the plan is up to date. Comprehensive inspections are done yearly with additional quarterly visual inspections done.

The IGP is set to expire on May 31, 2011. You may wish to check our website at <http://www.epa.ohio.gov/dsw/storm/index.aspx> periodically for any updates on the IGP renewal. Once the IGP is drafted and ready for public comment it will be available for viewing on our website.
