Dear Mr. Diller:

On June 30, 2010, Sarah Clement and I inspected the Combined Sewer Separation Phase 1 on Wayne Street in Fort Recovery in Mercer County. The purpose of our visit was to evaluate compliance of the site with your National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit for storm water discharge associated with construction activity, Facility ID No. 2GC02428\*AG. The inspection was conducted under the provisions of Ohio's water pollution control statutes, Ohio Revised Code (ORC) Chapter 6111. Mike Sovinski, of Choice One Engineering, was present to provide information on the project. The Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan and inspection logs were provided. The Ohio EPA has no record of other permittees on this site.

As a result of the inspection, I have the following comments:

1. At the time of inspection, construction at the site was ongoing. Wayne Street was the only street torn up at the time. The entire street was down to the gravel and the right of way was also torn up. The sewer was in place and the road was getting ready to be paved. Part 2 of Phase 1 is scheduled to start in about three weeks. Approximately 5 acres of land were disturbed and barren.
2. The Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan and the inspection logs were on site and adequate.
3. All of the inlets were above grade and no rainwater was entering them.
