Dear Mr. Sinito:

On May 22, 2007, the Millennia Housing Mgt., Ltd received coverage under the Ohio EPA General Permit for Storm Water Associated with Construction Activity (CGP) for the Port Clinton Pointe Apartments. This CGP is still active and you are named as a contact for this site.

On June 2, 2011, I performed an inspection of this facility, located at 1265 West Fremont Road, south of the City of Port Clinton, Ottawa County, OH. The purpose of this visit was to evaluate compliance of the site with the CGP. The inspection was conducted under the provisions of Ohio's water pollution control statutes, Ohio Revised Code (ORC) Chapter 6111. As a result of this inspection, it appears that coverage for this site is eligible to be terminated.

Construction activities have been completed with final stabilization achieved on all portions of this site. The CGP requires that a Notice of Termination (NOT) must be filed to relieve the applicant of the obligation to comply with the terms and conditions of this general permit including regular inspections of the site. I am enclosing an NOT form and instructions to terminate this permit.
