Dear Ms. Neiger:

You are hereby cited for a violation of the Ohio Administrative Code section 3745-19 (Open Burning Standards) and Portage County Air Pollution Control Regulation 97.16. This violation occurred on your property at 3829 Homestead Road in Rootstown Township (Portage County).

On September 28, 2009 our office received a complaint regarding open burning and smoke occurring on your property at 3829 Homestead Road in Rootstown Township. The complaint alleged that burning had occurred on September 27, 2009. During an investigation on September 28, 2009 the inspector observed an illegal burn site still smoldering and smoking. A written order to cease and desist all illegal open burning was issued at that time.

In light of this violation, you are urged to take appropriate steps to be sure that no further illegal open burning occurs on this property. **Within fifteen days of receipt of this letter, please submit a written commitment to cease all further illegal open burning.**

Acceptance by this Agency of your commitment does not constitute a waiver of this Agency's authority to seek civil penalties as provided in Portage County Air Pollution Control Regulation 97.16, or to refer the matter to the Ohio EPA for their enforcement action (including imposition of civil penalties). The determination to pursue or to decline such penalties will be made at a later date.



Dear Mr. & Mrs. Chadima:

You are hereby cited for violations of the Ohio Administrative Code section 3745-19 (Open Burning Standards) and Portage County Air Pollution Control Regulation 97.16 (Open Burning), as adopted in Resolution 91.01 of the Portage County Board of Health. These violations have occurred on your property at 2439 Industry Road in Randolph Township (Portage County).

On October 27, 2009 our agency received a complaint alleging open burning and smoke occurring on your property on October 27, 2009 at 6:15 p.m. During subsequent investigation on October 29, 2009 the complaint was found to be justified. Written orders to cease all illegal open burning activities were issued at that time.

Previously, on October 2, 2006 in response to an open burning complaint, you were contacted and the complaint was found to be justified. At that time the OAC 3745-19 Open Burning Standards were explained and you were given verbal orders to cease all illegal open burning activities.

In light of these violations, you are urged to take appropriate steps to be sure that no further illegal open burning occurs on this property. **Within fifteen (15) days of receipt of this letter, please submit a written commitment to cease all further illegal open burning.**

Acceptance by this Agency of your commitment does not constitute a waiver of this Agency's authority to seek civil penalties as provided in Portage County Air Pollution Control Regulation 97.16, or to refer the matter to the Ohio EPA for their enforcement action (including imposition of civil penalties). The determination to pursue or to decline such penalties will be made at a later date.
