Dear Mr. & Mrs. Abraham:

You are hereby cited for violations of the Ohio Administrative Code section 3745-19 (Open Burning Standards) and Summit County Health Code Part 20 Paragraph 97.01 (Open Burning). These violations have occurred on your property located at 1409 Fifth Street in the village of Lakemore (Summit County).

Our Agency has received ten open burning complaints on your property at 1409 Fifth Street in Lakemore since April 2008. Subsequent investigations by our inspector have revealed three violations of the Open Burning Standards. A letter regarding open burning and a copy of the Ohio Administrative Code 3745-19 Open Burning Standards were sent to you on May 12, 2009. The most recent violation occurred on May 24, 2009.

In light of this most recent violation, you are urged to take appropriate steps to be sure that no further illegal open burning occurs on this property. **Within fifteen (15) days of receipt of this letter, please submit a written commitment to cease all further illegal open burning.**

Acceptance by this Agency of your commitment does not constitute a waiver of this Agency's authority to seek civil penalties as provided in Summit County Health Code Part 20 Paragraph 97.01, or to refer the matter to the Ohio EPA for their enforcement action (including imposition of civil penalties). The determination to pursue or to decline such penalties will be made at a later date.
