Dear Mr. Lashley:

On May 15, 2012, I performed a compliance inspection of Rolling Hills Local School District's bus garage. The purpose of the inspection was to determine your facility's compliance with Ohio's hazardous waste laws and regulations as found in Chapter 3734 of the Ohio Revised Code (ORC) and Chapter 3745 of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC). This letter will explain the violations we found and what you need to do to correct the violations.

On May 21, 2012, a Notice of Violation letter was sent to you regarding used oil violations. On June 26, 2012, I visited the bus garage and noted that the used oil drums had been labeled properly. On August 5, 2012, I received a statement from you stating that all used oil generated at the bus garage would be collected by Heartland Petroleum (a registered used oil transporter). Therefore, Rolling Hills School District's bus garage has returned to compliance with the following hazardous waste rules:

- (i) OAC Rule 3745-279-22(C), Used oil storage requirements for generators;
- (ii) OAC rule 3745-279-24, Off-site shipments of used oil by generators.

You have now abated all violations cited from the May 15, 2012 inspection. If you have any questions regarding waste management or pollution prevention activities, please call me at (740) 380-5278.
