



Dear Mr. Sekel:

On May 7, 2009, you received coverage under the Ohio EPA General Permit for Storm Water Associated with Construction Activity (CGP) for the following facilities:

- Barn #1 – Joma Acres II, 1427 Ward Rd Van Wert County (permit #2GC02354)
- Barn #2 – Joma Acres I, 8544 Bowers Rd Van Wert County (permit #2GC02355)
- Barn #3 – Joma Acres II, 5145 Dull Robinson Rd Van Wert County (permit #2GC02356)
- Barn #4 – Joma Acres II, 8701 Rd 24 Paulding County (permit #2GC02357)
- Barn #5 – Joma Acres II, 9547 Rd 24 Paulding County (permit #2GC02358)
- Barn #6 – Joma Acres I, 1961 Collwel Rd Van Wert County (permit #2GC02359)

These permits are still active.

On July 29, 2010, I performed an inspection of each of these sites. The purpose of this visit was to evaluate compliance of each site with the CGP. The inspection was conducted under the provisions of Ohio's water pollution control statutes, Ohio Revised Code (ORC) Chapter 6111.

It appears that construction activities are complete at each site. Accordingly, a Notice of Termination (NOT) must be filed to relieve you of the obligation to comply with this general permit. An NOT can be filed if one or more of the following criteria are met:

- Final stabilization has been established on all areas of the site for which the permittee is responsible. Final stabilization means that either:
 1. All soil disturbing activities at the site are complete and a uniform perennial vegetative cover of at least 70% density has been established over the entire site. All temporary erosion and sediment control measures have been removed, properly disposed of, and all trapped sediment has been permanently stabilized; or
 2. For individual lots in a residential construction by either:
 - The homebuilder completing final stabilization as specified above or
