Dear Mr. Zottola:

On June 28, 2010, Sarah Clement and I inspected the Bryan Ohio Derailment in Center Township, Williams County. The purpose of our visit was to evaluate compliance of the site with your National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit for storm water discharge associated with construction activity, Facility ID No. 2GC02644*AG. The inspection was conducted under the provisions of Ohio's water pollution control statutes, Ohio Revised Code (ORC) Chapter 6111. Jeremy Heath, Site Supervisor, of Environmental Remediation Service, Inc, was present to provide information on the project. Ohio EPA has no record of other permittees for this site.

As a result of the inspection I have the following comments:

Construction at the site was complete and ERS Inc is waiting for approval to clean up and leave the site. The ditch where ethanol had been spilled due to a train derailment is being aerated and the banks of the ditch are covered with vegetation. A plastic material is covering the portion of the stream that is being aerated. Overall the site was in compliance with no evidence of sediment being discharged downstream.
