On July 24, 2012, I performed a hazardous waste inspection of your company to determine its compliance with Ohio's hazardous waste laws and regulations as found in Chapter 3734 of the Ohio Revised Code (ORC) and Chapter 3745 of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC).

Based on the observations and documentation reviewed during the inspection, Ohio EPA issued a notice of violation letter to you on July 26, 2012. On September 17, 2012, I received the sample results for the asphalt condensate. Based on these results, you have returned to compliance with the following hazardous waste regulation.

- i) OAC rule 3745-52-11, Hazardous waste determination.
