Dear Mr. Dirr:

On March 19, 2010, I performed an inspection of the Fifth Third Bank, located at 1232 N. Main St., Bowling Green, Wood County. The purpose of this visit was to evaluate compliance of the site with the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit for storm water discharges associated with construction activity. The inspection was conducted under the provisions of Ohio's water pollution control statutes, Ohio Revised Code (ORC) Chapter 6111. As a result of this inspection, it appears that your site is eligible to terminate your NPDES permit.

It appears that construction activities at Rite Aid Store No 2326, Perrysburg, Wood County are complete with final stabilization achieved on all portions of this site. Accordingly, a Notice of Termination (NOT) must be filed to relieve you of the obligation to comply with this general permit.
