

Dear Mr. Walton:

On November 17, 2010, I performed an inspection of the Hancock-Wood Electric Cooperative, located at 1399 Business Park Drive South, North Baltimore, Wood County. The purpose of this visit was to evaluate compliance of the site with the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit for storm water discharges associated with construction activity. The inspection was conducted under the provisions of Ohio's water pollution control statutes, Ohio Revised Code (ORC) Chapter 6111. As a result of this inspection, it appears that your site is eligible to terminate both of your NPDES permits.

Construction activities have been completed with final stabilization achieved on all portions of this site. The CGP requires that a Notice of Termination (NOT) must be filed to relieve you of the obligation to comply with the terms and conditions of this general permit including regular inspections of the site. I am enclosing two NOT forms and instructions for your convenience.
