## NOTICE OF VIOLATION

Dear Public Water System Owner:

To date, the Ohio EPA has not received the 2011 Consumer Confidence Report or Certification Form that was due by July 1, 2012. The VANLUE VILLAGE WATER public water system is in violation of Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) Rules 3745-96-01 through 04 for failure to comply with the Consumer Confidence Report requirements.

To return to compliance you must do the following:

1. Prepare a Consumer Confidence Report for 2011 and deliver a copy directly to each consumer within 10 days of the date of this letter.
2. Submit a copy of the Consumer Confidence Report within ten (10) days of the date of this letter to the Ohio EPA Central Office, DDAGW, P.O. Box 1049, Columbus, OH 43216-1049.
3. Submit a completed Consumer Confidence Report Certification Form to the Ohio EPA Central Office within 10 days of the date of this letter.
