Dear Mr. Barton:

On March 19, 2010, I performed an inspection of the Tim Hortons Restaurant, on the south side of E. Wooster St., East of Mercer Rd., Bowling Green, Wood County. The purpose of this visit was to evaluate compliance of the site with the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit for storm water discharges associated with construction activity. The inspection was conducted under the provisions of Ohio's water pollution control statutes, Ohio Revised Code (ORC) Chapter 6111. As a result of this inspection, it appears that your site is eligible to terminate your NPDES permit.

It appears that construction activities at Tim Hortons Restaurant, Bowling Green are complete with final stabilization achieved on all portions of this site. Accordingly, a Notice of Termination (NOT) must be filed to relieve you of the obligation to comply with this general permit. The NOT form and instructions may be found on our website at:
