WARNING LETTER

Dear Mr. Wooten:

On March 23, 2007, the Regional Air Pollution Control Agency (RAPCA), received a complaint from the Clark County Combined Health District regarding illegal open burning at 6900 W. National Road, New Carlisle, Ohio. The Clark County Combined Health District provided RAPCA with photographs of burn sites that showed evidence of open burning of plastic garbage bags, mattresses, bottles, metal, wood waste, furniture and other miscellaneous waste materials. Based on the Clark County Auditor, the property at 6900 W. National Road is 1.35 acres, and therefore the open burning was located within 1,000 feet of the nearest neighboring residence.

Pursuant to Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) rule and Clark County Combined Health District Air Pollution Control Regulations (CCCHDAPCR) 3745-19-04, Open burning in unrestricted areas, the open burning of materials containing rubber, grease, asphalt or liquid petroleum products, such as plastics and furniture, for the purposes of waste disposal is prohibited. Additionally, the open burning of any residential or agricultural waste for waste disposal purposes within 1,000 feet of the nearest neighboring inhabited residence is prohibited. Therefore, the open burning documented by the Clark County Combined Health District is a violation of OAC rule 3745-19-04.

This letter serves as notification to you of the above mentioned violations. **As the owner of the property, you may be held responsible for any illegal activity. A copy of the Warning Letter issued to the resident, Mechelle King, is also enclosed. Any further actions in violation of the above mentioned rules may result in an enforcement action with civil and/or criminal penalties.** If you have any questions, please contact me at 937-225-4004.

WARNING LETTER

Dear Ms. King:

On March 23, 2007, the Regional Air Pollution Control Agency (RAPCA), received a complaint from the Clark County Combined Health District regarding illegal open burning at 6900 W. National Road, New Carlisle, Ohio. The Clark County Combined Health District provided RAPCA with photographs of burn sites that showed evidence of open burning of plastic garbage bags, mattresses, bottles, metal, wood waste, furniture and other miscellaneous waste materials. Based on the Clark County Auditor, the property at 6900 W. National Road is 1.35 acres, and therefore the open burning was located within 1,000 feet of the nearest neighboring residence.

Pursuant to Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) rule and Clark County Combined Health District Air Pollution Control Regulations (CCCHDAPCR) 3745-19-04, Open burning in unrestricted areas, the open burning of materials containing rubber, grease, asphalt or liquid petroleum products, such as plastics and furniture, for the purposes of waste disposal is prohibited. Additionally, the open burning of any residential or agricultural waste for waste disposal purposes within 1,000 feet of the nearest neighboring inhabited residence is prohibited. Therefore, the open burning documented by the Clark County Combined Health District is a violation of OAC rule 3745-19-04.

This letter serves as notification to you of the above mentioned violations. **Any further actions in violation of the above mentioned rules may result in an enforcement action with civil and/or criminal penalties.** If you have any questions, please contact me at 937-225-4004.
