Dear Mr. Hall:

On February 22, 2010, the Agency received a copy of a Disinfectants/Disinfection Byproducts Sample Monitoring Plan prepared by Michael Suever, Water Superintendent.

Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) Rule 3745-81-70 requires each public water system required to monitor for disinfectant residuals to develop and implement a monitoring plan. A plan, developed in accordance with specific instructions and template, was specified as a requirement to be completed within 45 days of receiving written notice (reference enclosed correspondence dated January 8, 2010) following the sanitary survey conducted December 9, 2009.

Review of the Disinfectants/Disinfection Byproducts Sample Monitoring Plan dated February 9, 2010 noted several deficiencies (see enclosure). The Disinfectants/Disinfection Byproducts Sample Monitoring Plan shall be revised and resubmitted by June 7, 2010.
